Course Description:

This qualification reflects the roles of experienced practitioners delivering training and assessment services usually within Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) within the vocational education and training (VET) sector. They may have a role in leading other trainers and assessors and in providing mentoring or advice to new trainers or assessors as well as designing approaches to learning and assessment strategies across a significant area within the RTO.

Delivery Options and Cost:

- Group workshops supported by individual mentoring: \$3,300
- Distance delivery with individual mentoring and support: \$3,300
- RPL assessment with individual mentored support: \$2,400
- Gap training per unit: \$330
- RPL per unit: \$240

Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification, however it is desirable that candidates are employed in a role where they have maintained currency within the VET (Vocational Education and Training) sector and have either TAE40110 or TAE40116 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment.

Recommended Duration and Volume of Learning

The volume of learning for the Diploma of Vocational Education and Training as a Learning and Assessment pathway is typically 1 to 2 years (1200 – 2400 hours).
